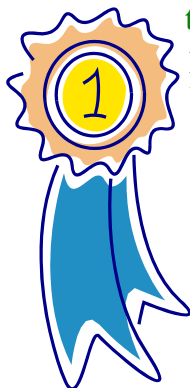


2013 Niagara Frontier Chapter ASSE Safety Professional of the Year (SPY)
